Skills Bus We also have a Skills for Employment bus onsite on certain dates down at EOS, this is available for KS3. You have the access to various tools and are taught how to handle them safely. You will be able to create anything from bird boxes to benches. Anything out of wood!

Willow Farm

The children will experience a wide range of activities at the farm which will provide them with the opportunity to work through challenges and gain confidence in a peaceful, relaxed, safe and secure environment. Work on the farm contributes to their personal growth and social awareness and also helps them to develop skills for life. This a family run, working farm with a variety of farm animals.

Equine Therapy

Equine Assisted Learning can be used as an alternative provision for children and young people that are finding mainstream schooling difficult to access and are at risk of exclusion. This experiential way of learning, learning through reflection on doing, provides opportunities for students to engage in situations that require interaction with the horse and facilitator to encourage the development of new skills that can be applied to other life situations.



Horse Riding

Horse riding improves your confidence, the control

over your emotions and your self-esteem when we achieve to control a horse through aids.

Keeping a horse under control improves our memory, concentration and attention span. Being responsible for a horse reinforces feelings such as respect and responsibility.
