



Exams, results and destinations - 2015/2016

Key Stage 2

Our Key Stage 2 students join us in year 6, following an early transition from their Primary school. This cohort of students is small and in the academic year 2015/2016 only two students were in a position to publish results.

One of our students' reached the expected standards or above in reading, writing and Maths.

The average scale score in: reading at 108, Maths 100.5 and SPAG at 104.

Neither of our students tested achieved a high level of achievement in reading, writing **and** maths, yet we are pleased to say that both achieved a higher level of attainment in reading.

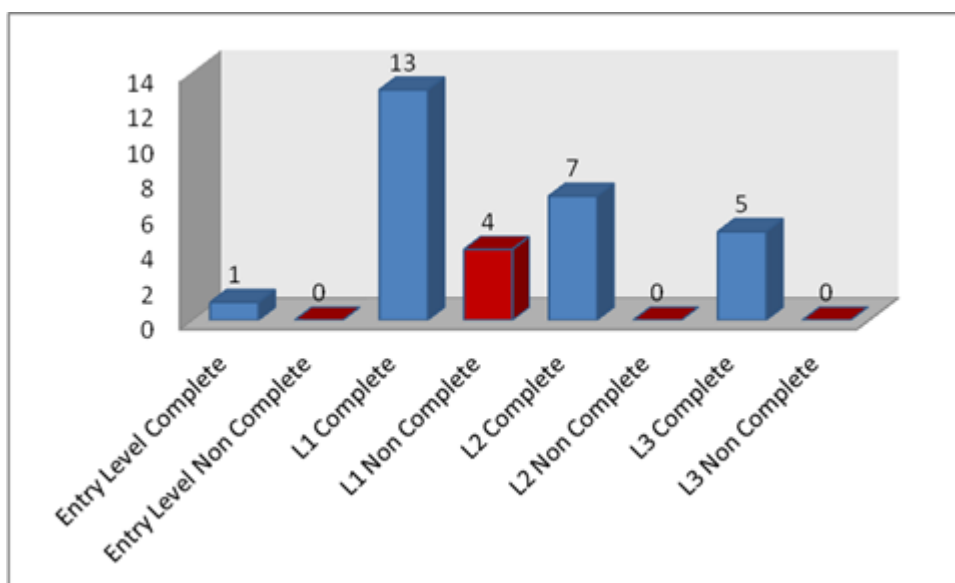

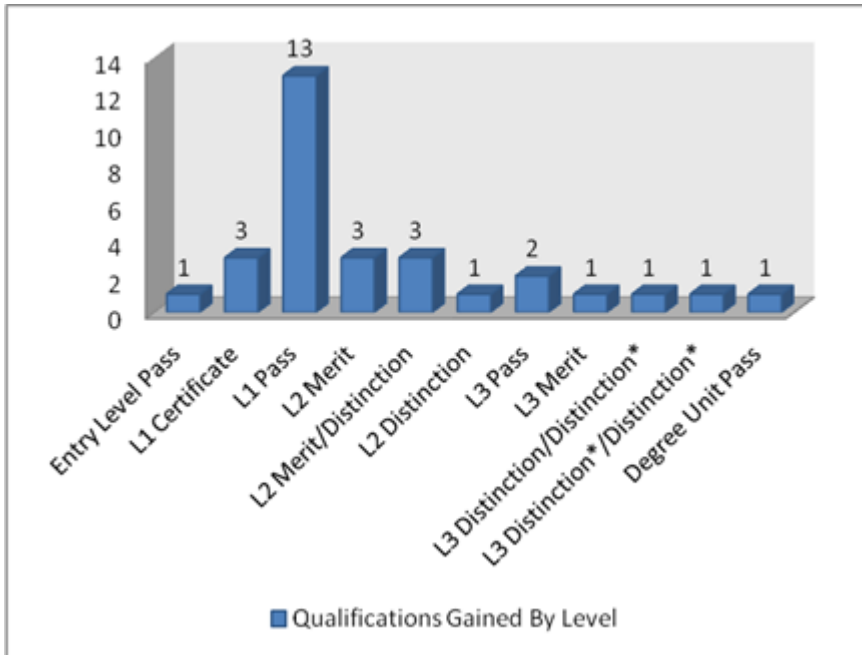
Of our 21 students transitioning from year 11 to Key Stage 5 (Post 16); 18 students remained with West Heath accessing provision in school or with one of our eight possible Further Education providers, 1 student went on to access their college provision independently, 1 continued their study independently from home and 1 student's destination is unknown. This equates to 95% of our learners continuing in education or training.

Key Stage 5

Our students follow the national guidelines for Further Education and as such they continue to study toward an improved qualification in English and Maths. At the end of the academic year 2015-16 of the students requiring an improved grade in English, 59% were successful in doing this. In Maths 46% were successful in improving their grade.

In 2015/2016 the majority of our students studied toward a Level 1 qualification with half as many studying toward at Level 2 and Level 3 qualification respectively.

Over the course of 2015-16, 52 students were on-roll of which we can report:

- 1 left during the year to become an independent learner at College (1.9%)
- 4 left during the year after their college placement broke down (7.8%)
- 5 finished the school year after difficult placement (9.6%)
- 42 finished the school year after successful placement (80.8%)

Following the academic year 2015-16, the 47 students that finished went on to do the following:

- 25 continued on-roll at West Heath School (53.2%)
- 2 went to university (4.3%)
- 3 went on to paid employment (6.4%)
- 9 went on to continued further education or training (19.1%)
- 2 went on to specialist SEN providers (4.3%)
- 5 currently unknown destinations (10.6%)
- 1 other (2.1%)
